- Electric energy (solar panels or offshore wind farm) for entire community - water treatment, urban transportation, lighting etc..
- Environmentally friendly living —
 - clean energy (above)
 - continuing effort to plant trees (oxygen sources) and establish POCKET PARKS throughout community
 - minimal impact on creeks w/ use a seawater based desal water supply
